The Textiles Project Group met twice in the 2015 period, first in Kendal, UK in April and then

in Prague, Czech Republic in October

Given the current activities within OECD to both harmonise testing methods for basic activity

and promote claim-specific tests for product registration, especially under the BPR, IBRG will

continue to concentrate on looking at the in-use simulation of antimicrobial effects. Therefore

the activities of IBRG for the next few years will continue to be focussed on the development

of test protocols to allow the function of treated porous materials under simulated real-life

scenarios to be explored. Initial ring tests on a simulation of the effects of treated textiles on the

survival of bacteria delivered by contaminated, small splashes of liquids is in progress.

A method to model the control of odour has been developed and was subjected to a small ring

test. This work will continue and the method has been refined further and other models are

under investigation.
